I particularly like 'One Water' – profits from this product go to build children's roundabouts in African villages which double as water pumps to provide clean drinking to the village. This means that instead of spending time walking miles to collect water, the children can go to school. When my customers buy the water I always tell them to read the story on the bottle!"

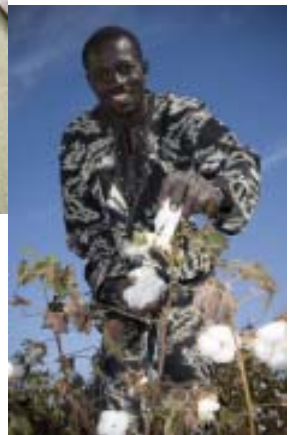
